

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE!

You have just arrived in Brimfield and face a sea of dealers and merchandise. You are searching for Furniture and Sterling Silver. Begin your search by:

1. **CATEGORIES:** Begin your search by browsing the general category list in the column to the right on this page. Choose a category and look for the heading listed alphabetically in this guide.

2. **DEALERS:** are listed alphabetically under each category heading. Each dealer listing contains three columns of information. You will find the dealer's name, the name of the show (abbreviated) where they display, and their booth number.

3. **FINDING A DEALER:** After finding a dealer in your chosen category, refer to the color show map on pages 20 & 21. Find the show's location, the opening dates, and the days the show remains open. Noting the show schedule is helpful as different shows open on different days and times.

4. **OTHER HELPFUL TIPS:** When you arrive at a particular show and still cannot find the dealer or merchandise you are looking for, try asking the show promoter or a fellow dealer. They can be very helpful. Remember that you can do a more detailed category search on **BrimfieldExchange.com** from the comfort of your home. Here you can search with more specific terms i.e. Czech, or Royal Doulton or Pop Culture, or you may want to locate a specific dealer by name. **NOTE!** Some dealers use their business names and some use their personal names. Some dealers have links from their online listing to their own website, online store or business cards.

Brimfield Shoppers Speak Out

By Randall Decoteau

I guess most people in the antiques business end up at Brimfield sooner or later. After all, many consider it the most exciting antiques market in the country. Well more than 5,000 dealers converge on this small central Massachusetts town every May, July, and September dragging a mind-boggling assortment of wares with them.

There are more than 20 different fields that stretch as far as the eye can see down both sides of Route 20. And hoardes of people flock here in search of their ultimate desire in antiques and collectibles. These die-hards come to buy in searing heat and bone-chilling cold, in rain and in wind, and in dry dust or mud up to their knees. The

cars, vans, and trucks bear license plates from every state in the Union. If you listen, the languages you'll hear will be from Japan, France, England, Germany, Venezuela, Hong Kong, India, and myriad other countries. Somehow, the word gets out that this is the place to be.

The smells of barbecue, kettle corn, and ethnic foods as well as the sounds of vendors hawking their wares permeate the air adding to the carnival atmosphere. And people often look like they are ready for excitement. Some put on their most eccentric costumes, while others top their all-weather outfit with a crazy hat or zany footwear. People wear signs telling the world that they want fountain pens, opera collectibles, Boy Scout items, or cast iron cookware. Yes, Brimfield is

the place to be every summer, and NEAJ was there to listen to what shoppers had to say about this year's shows.

Hilde Whalley, Worcester, MA



My partner and I like real antiques and we like them old. We go for things that are interesting – objects of art, Americana, Oriental stuff, and we love Christmas things, looking glasses, and barometers. Today we bought a nice little Austrian bronze and a stunning gilded Buddha yesterday. We'd really like to find a nice big pond yacht with perfect rigging. We're not asking for much! I've been coming to Brimfield for six years and Allen has been doing this for well over twenty years. I notice this year that collectors are pickier, and there seem to be fewer entry-level buyers. I don't think anybody ever shops the whole show, no matter how far they get. We like Lois Shelton's field because of location, traffic patterns, and the like. My sense is that the people who run the field are present and are there when anybody needs them. We spend the whole week here. I think the major advantage of shopping Brimfield is that if you look long enough, you'll find whatever you want. You have to deal with New England weather, though. You need to bring a boat as well as a camel and use

both over the course of the week.

We buy stained glass, and enjoy vintage furniture, which I restore. Occasionally, we have bought hanging kerosene lamps, which can be pricey, but there is enough of a selection to make the buying process easier. We find it interesting to see the amount of people here and the variety of things they buy. This morning we bought a ceramic hen and rooster for just \$38. We have an old farm that at one time was a chicken farm, so we like things having to do with poultry. We have a list of interesting things to come back to, but after we return to the fields, we are going to find a stained glass window for a new entryway we are going to build this fall. My wife and I have been coming to Brimfield for only three years, and usually we spend two days shopping. Every day and every hour here is an adventure; it's certainly not a place to be bored. This year we found some Westerwald stoneware, which is exciting for us. We try to cover about half of the show in one quick walkthrough, which is quite a task. After that you really need to take time to evaluate, to look, and to ask questions. Dealers will always work with you on price, and the food is terrific – we just had the barbecued chicken. I'd

like to see more dealers take credit cards, but the variety here is the real advantage.

My husband and I collect a lot of different things. We love paintings, porcelain, and Depression glass. I collect candlesticks and my husband likes walking sticks, but sometimes we don't know what we want until we see it. We haven't bought anything yet today, but we're sort of looking for a European oil painting from the 1870-1890 period. This is our first time at Brimfield, but we've always wanted to come. We're combining this with a trip to Quebec and we're glad to be here in this gorgeous countryside. One of the reasons we chose Brimfield is that the dollar is so weak we don't want to be buying in Europe this year. We're staying way out in Bedford, so I'm not sure how many days we'll spend here. So far, we've only covered Shelton's and Sturtevant's fields. We find the dealers here very friendly and affable. I think antique dealers are nice anyway. I'll tell you that we found a parking space really easily, but a disadvantage for us is that we are flying home, so we are limited to buying smaller items that won't have to be packed and crated.

I'm a dealer and collector, so most of the stuff I collect, I turn around and sell. I like vintage fabrics, planters, shabby chic furniture, glassware, and whatever else catches my eye that's different. I ship it all home. Yesterday, I bought a vintage child's swimsuit at the textile show in Sturbridge – most of the stuff is in the car, so I have to



think a minute about what else I bought. This morning I found an adorable display piece for children's clothes that's red and white with very graphic teddy bears on it, and it says *Here is How We Hang our Clothes*. I just love it. Now I'm finding vintage children's fashion to hang on it in the shop. Today I really want to find a complete set of Christmas dishes, but I haven't seen much of that kind of stuff yet. This is my third time here. I shop every field and visit every dealer. I take the whole week to do it. From early morning to the time they shut down, I'm here. I think J&J's field is my favorite. It's clean and well organized, has a nice food area, and I really appreciate the variety of the merchandise and good pricing. Dealers are always willing to bargain with you as long as you are polite. One thing I like about Brimfield is that everything is centrally located – not like Round Top in Texas. This one is really compact, and I want to emphasize how friendly the people here are.

I'm here with my girlfriends and we like 19th century doorstops, Chinese

mud figures, and pattern glass, especially Spooners. We love McCoy, books, and of course, jewelry. I found this great book of trading cards like we had as kids. I've been looking for these for years, and none of them even have writing on the back. This is an awesome find! We are still looking for some English china, like Spode Bluebird pattern. We've been shopping here for 20 years easy. It's still as much fun, but everybody is so savvy today. There are fewer deals. The market is large and the crowds are huge today. There is so much more food, though, and that is good. We come here only for one day and we are lucky to cover even one quarter of the show. We don't really have a favorite field, but we always shop Heart-O-The-Mart and like it a lot. Today, we started at Dealer's Choice and worked our way down. No matter what you're looking for, you'll find it here. But, we hate the heat in July, and usually only come here in May and September.

I collect a lot of different things like old advertising and pottery like McCoy frogs, yellow ware bowls, and Roseville. We bought some tobacco tins today and one nice piece of McCoy that was priced right. I would love to find a Southern brewery lithograph, which we haven't yet found, but there's still tomorrow and Thursday. I've been coming here since the late 70s, probably 30 years. The quality of merchandise seems to be drying up. There are fewer antiques today and more crafts and decorative items. This stuff was always here but not in the profusion that we see today. I've also noticed a gradual shift to retail pricing.

We really try to shop the whole market. We'll be here two and a half days and will really cover it. We shop shows all around the country, but Brimfield is still the King in terms of numbers of dealers. Actually, my favorite field is Heart-O-The-Mart. There are still folks who wholesale there and I kind of like going back by the water. I also like the opening at Herten's. It's sheer pandemonium and it's still free. I don't think much about advantages and such. If there were too many disadvantages, we wouldn't come back.

I'm into clocks, steam engines, small model engines, toys, and tools for clock and watch making. Today, I bought a watchmaker's lathe and pieces to go with it that I don't have – and they are kind of rare, so that's good. I'd love to find a small model hot air engine this afternoon. Jeez, it's got to be maybe 20 years now since I first shopped Brimfield, but I've been coming pretty steady now for eight years. There have been lots of changes in prices, and now there are a lot more people, but the shows still have a lot of good antiques to buy. I never shop the whole show because I go slowly and when I see a booth I like, I really look at it pretty close. You miss stuff when you go zooming by. I only spend one day here, and usually go to May's, but I like some of these other fields like Quaker Acres. The best advantage here is a good selection. You don't have to go all over the place visiting auctions and fleas. It's all here. Ten dollar parking is a disadvantage, though.

I love glass, especially Heisey, Chinese Export, Victorian clothing, and bridge memorabilia. Some of my collections are big – some are smaller. I bought two things today: a little Satsuma flask-shaped bud vase and a very nice hand-painted Austrian biscuit jar for 40 dollars. How bad can that be? I really want to find a fabulous piece of Heisey that I can show at the convention in Ohio in June. I don't come to Brimfield unless I'm in a perfect mood. It's exhausting, but I'm loving it today. By the time I started shopping here it was already junky, but there is still a decent balance between good things and junk. As to shopping the whole place, I have to laugh. I figure if I can do half to three-quarters of one field, I'm lucky. I always find more if I go slowly and I spend a lot of time talking with people. I spend one day here and New England Motel is my favorite field followed by Quaker Acres. If I'm in a good mood, I'll come back for the Girls (J&J) on Friday. I think it's overwhelming to drag yourself around in the hope that you are going to find a score in a booth where they don't know what they are doing. It's not going to happen, but a smart buyer might just find a little quality out there at a price.

I usually buy Chinese porcelain, antique English silver, and hopefully this time, a good Impressionist painting. I haven't bought a thing yet, but I've seen several items I'm considering. One is a 19th century mantel clock in wonderful condition and the other is a forest scene by a New Jersey artist



for only \$2,800. I've been coming to Brimfield longer than I care to admit, maybe 40 years now. The growth of the market has been incredible, but it's still very interesting to listen to the uninitiated and see how fascinated they are with things that seem old hat to the old timers. It's impossible to shop it all; it's too big and there are too many dealers to cover in a single day. You really have to be here several days. My favorite field has always been May's. I have found my best buys there and there are always dealers on that field who have what I'm looking for. I don't really think that this place is any different from anywhere else. Remember *caveat emptor*. If you come with a lack of knowledge, beware. Just an hour ago, I saw that famous self-portrait of Rembrandt that looked like it was painted by Helen Keller, if you know what I mean.

It was a trivet and I never saw this piece in the eight to ten years I've been collecting. We are dealers and we always buy what we think will sell in the Midwest. Today I'd like to find the water skier motion lamp, you know, one of those from the 1950s. It's one I don't have. This is our tenth year in Brimfield. It seems to me like there are a lot more people now, and it's way harder to park these days. We don't get up that early, yet there still seem to be enough bargains for everybody. And we probably won't cover everything even though we'll be here until Saturday. We come here only once per year and we stay all week. We like either May's or that one across the street that doesn't open until Friday. But when we get a good buy, then that's our new favorite field. That's how it goes. There is hardly a thing here that you don't see. Variety is good, but the disadvantages are how far we have to travel to find all this stuff, and the traffic!





